

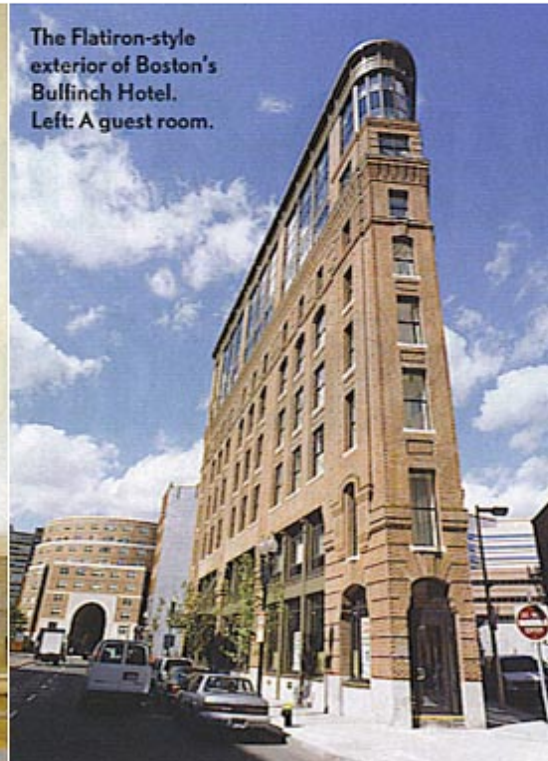

BOSTON- The **Bulfinch Hotel** (107 Merrimac Street; 617-624-0202; www.bulfinchhotel.com; Doubles from \$169) brought in Campion A.
